From the Academic Senate for California Community Colleges:

This year's Academic Senate Vocational Education Leadership Institute, focusing on leadership throughout the California community colleges, will be held at the San Francisco Airport Westin on **March 21-23, 2012** (<http://www.asccc.org/events/2012/03/voc-ed-leadership-institute>). It is offered concurrently with CCCOAE's Spring Conference (<http://cccao.org/conference/InfoAgenda.html>). General sessions will be held jointly, and faculty members attending the Vocational Education Leadership Institute can also attend any CCCAOE breakout session at no extra cost.

Our goal this year is to increase opportunities throughout the joint events to ask questions, raise issues and concerns, share strategies and experiences, and develop a network of support between all CTE constituents, be they faculty, staff or administrators.

Faculty attendance is limited to occupational education faculty members or counseling faculty who work directly with occupational education students. Attendance at the Institute, including a double occupancy hotel room and transportation, is subsidized, so there is no cost to faculty attendees\*. This grant limits support to 80 faculty attendees, however all persons beyond this capacity may register to attend the combined event through CCCAOE.

To encourage registration for first time attendees, faculty members who have attended a previous Vocational Education Leadership institute within the last three years will be placed on a waiting list until the pre-registration deadline.

Registration is now open for the Academic Senate's 2012 Vocational Education Leadership Institute (<http://www.asccc.org/content/2012-voc-ed-registration>). Form a partnership right now - encourage your CTE serving faculty to attend today!
