The CAP/EarlyEdU Crosswalk Project

In Fall 2018, First 5 California (F5CA) funded CDTC to create a crosswalk between the CD/ECE CAP aligned course content and the EarlyEdU courses available for free with [EarlyEdU Alliance®](#) membership. California's CAP aligned content, taken as a whole, closely relates to the inventory of EarlyEdU competency-based resources. The purpose of the Crosswalk Project is to support California faculty in accessing the resources available through EarlyEdU that can be used to enhance instruction and enrich student experiences and outcomes.

The CAP/EarlyEdU Crosswalk Institute

Faculty will be able to practice using the Crosswalk and integrating EarlyEdU content (i.e., videos, practice-based and reflective assignments) into their own courses as well as explore various uses of the Coaching Companion and the extensive multimedia library. Faculty will have a chance to connect with other faculty in the state and across the country who are working to implement the EarlyEdU approach in serving the needs of the early childhood workforce. Those working on Zero Textbook Cost (ZTC) courses will find a wealth of resources to support their efforts. The EarlyEdU instructional design and technology support team will be onsite to support participants.

Hotel accommodations and meals during the Crosswalk Institute will be provided. Participants will be reimbursed for travel expenses at the state rate.

Eligibility and Participation Requirements

All community college CD/ECE faculty who regularly teach CAP aligned courses are eligible to attend.

The following three steps must be completed by the deadline to secure a spot at the Crosswalk Institute:

1. Register using the link below by April 12th, 2019
2. Join the [EarlyEdU Alliance®](#) at either an individual or institutional level (IHE) (both are free) by April 30th, 2019
3. Complete the online orientation, self-paced onboarding modules (EarlyEdU Onboarding), by May 12, 2019. You will be enrolled in the modules upon joining the EarlyEdU Alliance.

Upon completion of the above three steps, participants will receive a final confirmation with hotel and travel information. Space is limited.
